WHAT IS IT

The National Leaders in SEMH Programme for Governors is a term-long course designed to empower those who support, guide and oversee educational settings.

Suitable for the designated Governor for Mental Health and Wellbeing in educational settings (any age).

Delivered in a group, the programme covers topics affecting the governance of social, emotional and mental health in our young people and staff. Sessions encourage the sharing of good practice, plus the development of new knowledge and skills.

Participants study core modules with a facilitator and self-study an additional two modules, allowing them to ensure the learning is most suitable for their situation. The course is assessed through a portfolio submission, marked by the facilitator in order to gain the accreditation.

COURSE COMMITMENT

In-person

2 x full days, with a half a term in-between them.

Online

6 x monthly 90 minute workshops (with a gap for the summer holidays).

Additional commitment

Between sessions there are activities which a Governor may need to undertake. In addition governors self-study two units.

HOW IT IS DELIVERED

The programme can be delivered online or in-person for local cohorts.

The Root Of It also work with selected local partners on a Train the Trainer basis, such as Educational Psychology services, teaching schools, special schools or consultants.

HOW IT IS ASSESSED

Governors submit a brief portfolio based on their learning from the Programme:

- Reflection on the learning from the course
- Evidence of self-studied units
- Workplace testimony
